

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The CADR Journal of Dispute Resolution (CJDR) accepts submissions from academicians, legal practitioners, research scholars and students encompassing the theme of ‘Latest Trends in the field of Alternative Dispute Resolution‘.

Contribution Guidelines

The CADR Journal invites contributions in the following categories –

1. Articles – Between 5,000 – 7,000 words, inclusive of footnotes.
2. Essays – Between 3,000 – 5,000 words inclusive of footnotes.
3. Case Notes/ Legislative Comments/ Book/ Article Reviews – Between 1,500 – 3,000 words, inclusive of footnotes.

Formatting Guidelines

1. The manuscript should be in English and should have a title and a brief synopsis/ introduction of the chosen topic.
2. Submissions should be in Times New Roman font, size 12, 1.5 line spacing, justified text, and 1-inch margins on all sides.
3. Footnotes should be in Times New Roman font of size 10 with 1.0 line spacing. Endnotes are not allowed.
4. Citations and footnotes should be in accordance with OSCOLA (4th Edition).

Other Guidelines

1. Co-authorship for the manuscripts is permissible. However, the number of co-authors must not exceed two.
2. All manuscripts must necessarily be accompanied with an abstract of not more than 250 words.
3. The author(s) are also required to provide their biographical information in a separate cover letter along with an undertaking that the manuscript is the original work of the author.
4. While the submission is under the process of review, it shall not be considered for publication by any other platform. Failure to do so will lead to removal of the piece for consideration for publication in the Journal.

5. Submission(s) made by the Author(s) shall not be plagiarized and the editorial board has the right to reject a plagiarized manuscript.
6. All manuscripts will be subject to the Journal's double-blind review process.

Submission Deadline

CJDR accepts manuscripts on call basis. Presently we are not accepting any submission. The deadline for the next Issue will be notified in due course. However, the authors can submit their manuscripts for CADR Blog.

How to Submit?

The manuscript shall be submitted in .doc/.docx format (Microsoft Office 2007 or above). Manuscripts should be submitted electronically to cadr@nludelhi.ac.in with the title "Submission – CJDR".
